

Report of Medical Camp by Department of *Kaumarabhritya*

Department of *Kaumarabhritya* in association with Department of *Prasootitantra* and *Striroga* conducted a two days medical camp on 28/1/25 and 29/1/25 in **Adya Academy school, Swami Vivekananda Road, Jigni, Anekal, Bangalore**. Dr. Champa Pant HOD & Professor, Department of *Kaumarabhritya* was given the responsibility of the camp.

On 28/1/25 a total of 62 children and on 29/1/25 a total of 92 children were examined. Overall a total of 168 children were screened by department of *Kaumarabhritya* for various health issues. Healthy children were educated about importance of nutritious food, physical activities and less screen time. Many children with *Balashosha* (stunting, underweight for age), *Kushtha* (skin conditions), *Kasa/Shwasa* (respiratory issues), *Tundikeri* (Tonsillitis, Adenoids), *Pandu* (anaemia) and general debility.

These children were referred to *Kaumarabhritya* OPD.

Additionally, 23 teenage girls were screened for various health issues. They were educated about the menstrual hygiene and other menstruation related issues. All female staff of the school was given consultation. Those requiring further evaluation were referred to PTSR department.
