ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS & EYE DONATION VISIT REPORT**

Department of Agada Tantra Evam Vidhi Vaidyaka organized an educational visit on Organ Donation Awareness with special reference to Eye Donation at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bengaluru for II BAMS students (2023-2024 batch) on 22nd and 24th April 2026. The visit aimed to sensitize students regarding the importance of organ donation and to provide practical exposure to eye donation procedures and medico-legal aspects.

College bus left the campus at 8:30 am and reached Victoria Hospital at 10:00 am via Vega City Mall. The students were accompanied by faculty members of the Department.

During the visit, students were oriented by the concerned department regarding the concept and significance of organ donation, legal regulations, and ethical considerations. Special emphasis was given to eye donation as an effective means to restore vision in corneal blindness.

Students were given the opportunity to observe the eye donation procedure (enucleation) carried out by trained professionals under aseptic conditions. The steps of corneal retrieval, preservation, and transportation to the eye bank were demonstrated. They were also briefed about donor consent, time limits for retrieval, and screening of donors.

Awareness was created regarding the role of medical professionals in motivating the public for organ donation and addressing myths and misconceptions. Students actively interacted with the experts and clarified their doubts regarding organ donation processes and medico-legal implications.

The visit provided valuable practical insight and reinforced the importance of organ donation in saving lives and improving quality of life. The bus left the hospital at 4:15 pm and reached campus at 6:00 pm. Photographs of the visit are attached as annexures with the report.
