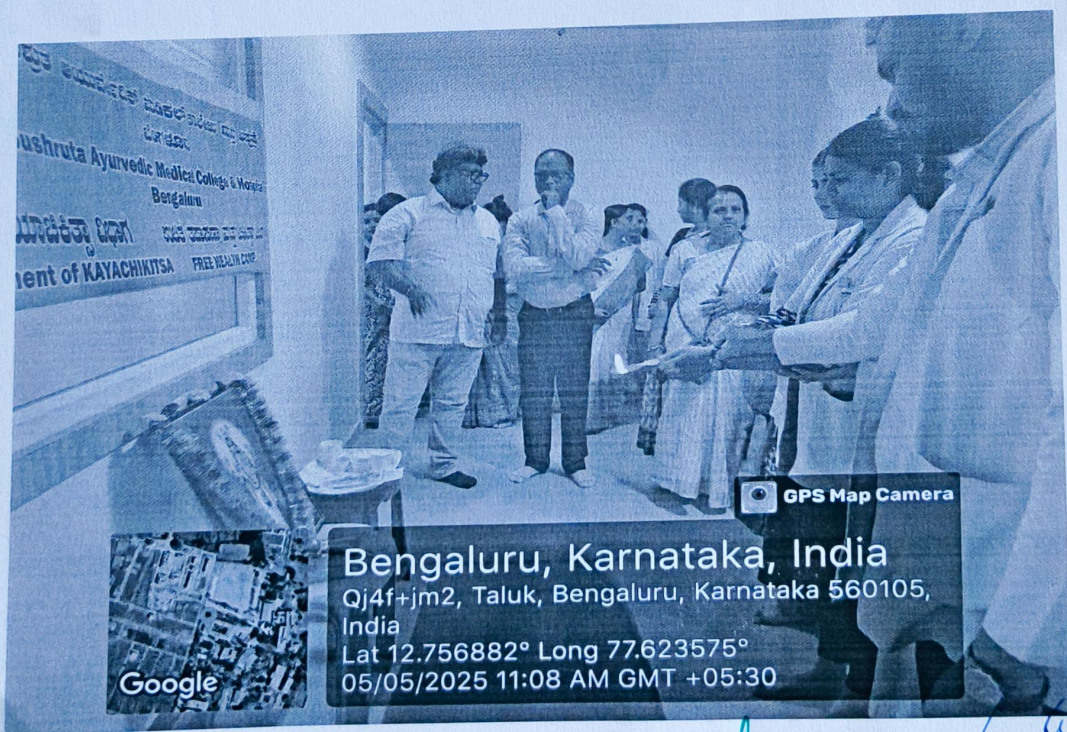
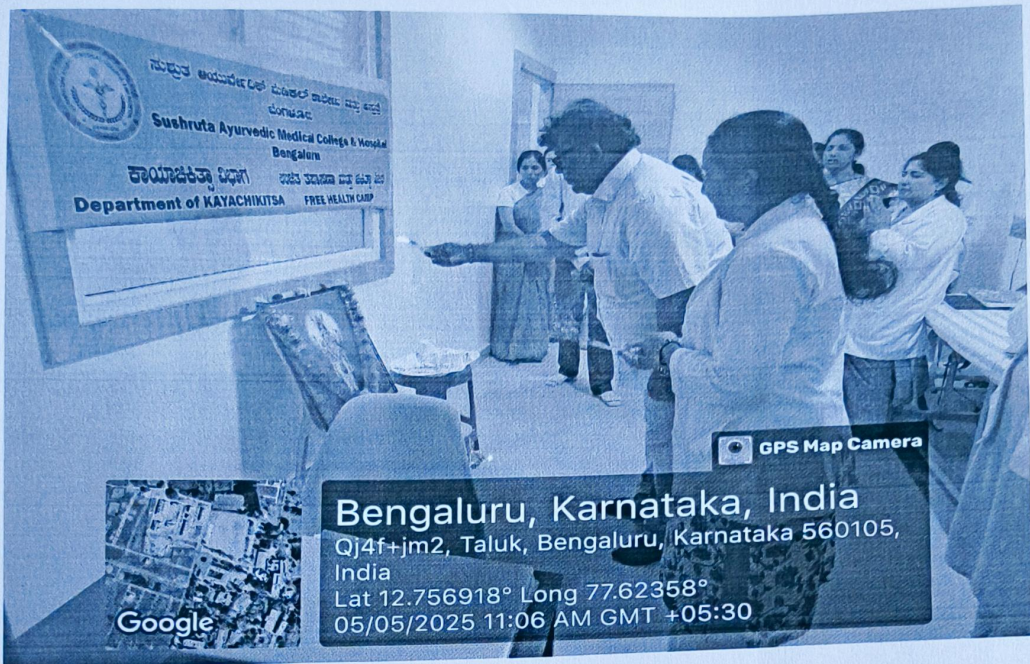
Conclusion:
