FORENSIC MUSEUM, TOXICOLOGY LAB & BALLISTIC MUSEUM VISIT REPORT

Department of Agada Tantra Evam Vidhi Vaidyaka organized a 2-day educational visit to the Forensic Museum, Toxicology Laboratory, and Ballistic Museum at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bengaluru. The visit was conducted for II BAMS students (2023-2024 batch) to enhance their practical exposure to forensic science and toxicology. Students were divided into two batches of 48 each (Group A & Group B).

Day 1 (21.04.2026 – Batch A):

College bus left the campus at 8:30 am and reached Victoria Hospital at 10:00 am via Vega City Mall. Dr. Sandhya D S and Dr. Jayalakshmi K M Accompanied Batch A students.

Students visited the Forensic Museum where they were exposed to preserved specimens demonstrating various causes of death such as burns, septicemia, poisoning, and homicidal injuries. They were oriented about medico-legal importance and identification of specimens.

In the afternoon session, students visited the Ballistic Museum where they were oriented regarding identification and analysis of firearms and weapons. They observed different types of guns, bullets, and cartridges and learned about wound ballistics and firearm injuries. Demonstrations included differentiation of entry and exit wounds.

The bus left Victoria Hospital at 4:15 pm and reached campus at 6:00 pm.

Day 2 (23.04.2026 – Batch B):

College bus left the campus at 8:30 am and reached Victoria Hospital at 10:00 am via Vega City Mall. Dr. Sandhya D S and Dr. Harish Babu H accompanied Batch B students. Students were oriented by postgraduate scholars and faculty in the Forensic Museum. They observed specimens related to infectious diseases such as tuberculosis, congenital anomalies, and unidentified bodies, along with medico-legal documentation and preservation techniques.

Students also visited the Toxicology Laboratory where they were briefed on analysis of various poisons and medico-legal case handling. Practical demonstration of toxicological investigations and interpretation of reports were explained.

Further, students visited the Ballistic Museum where they gained knowledge regarding firearm identification, types of ammunition, and their medico-legal significance. Case discussions included hanging and dowry deaths, with emphasis on forensic interpretation.

The bus left at 4:30 pm and reached campus by 6:30 pm. The photographs of the visit are attached as annexures with the report.
